Gnathostoma - develop within fish.

Gnathostoma rarely affects dogs, but given the right circumstances, dogs can be susceptible with deadly results.

Gnathostoma larvae **develop within fish**, and when fish are eaten by a larger animal, the larvae are released and burrow through the body of the host animal, returning to the stomach as mature worms that attach to the stomach lining of the host.

If a nodule forms around the attachment site in the host, and that nodule breaks, stomach contents can leak into the host's body, causing infection and sometimes death.
