Today, more than ever, your dog comes into contact with environmental toxins.

Just breathing the air, indoors or out, romping through grass and garden, and lapping up tap water or puddles outside, your dog comes into contact with toxins and chemicals.

Today our dogs are more polluted than ever.

A 2008 report from the Environmental Working Group found, in the first study of its kind, that pets' blood and urine are polluted with even higher levels of many of the same chemicals found in the average human.

For dogs, blood and urine samples were contaminated with a total of 35 chemicals.

No matter the source, incidental or unintentional, toxins and chemicals can accumulate in your dog's body - our domestic dogs ingest and absorb more than their fair share of our environmental toxins.

If your dog is young and healthy, their body can typically clear away many toxins and wastes through their natural detoxification systems - the liver and kidneys.

Using a two part system, your dog's **liver** performs the biggest detox job of all.

Part 1 breaks down environmental toxins and wastes in the body.

Part 2 neutralizes and prepares toxins for excretion.

To support both phases of detoxification, your dog's body requires an adequate supply of nutrients, antioxidants, and cofactors.

At the same time, many of those same nutrients help protect against free radical damage.

Supporting your dog's natural detoxification system starts with digestion.

First, make sure your dog's digestion is optimal.

No matter their age, all dogs need to have a healthy liver and kidneys to handle the toxins and chemicals that enter their body.

What's one of the most important ways to help maintain your pet's liver & kidney health?

Support their digestive function.

If your dog's digestive function is less-than-optimal, the liver and kidneys must assume the task of breaking down nutrients and filtering out toxins.

When your dog's digestion works optimally, their liver and kidneys are better able to do their intended jobs.

When your dog's normal detox processes become less-than-optimal.

A buildup of toxins can overtax your pet's normal detoxification processes.

Age, stress, injury, and a host of other contributors can result in less-than-optimal detoxification for your dog.

Sometimes the buildup of toxins simply becomes too great for your dog's body to handle.

If toxins & waste can't be removed through normal detox processes, several problems arise, including;

Your dog's body attempts to remove the excess toxins through their skin, resulting in itchy, scaly, and dry skin.

Your dog's body tries to shed toxins and waste through mucous membranes, leading to eye discharge, teary eyes, or a runny nose.

Your dog's body stores the overload of toxins to be handled later.

Toxins and unwanted waste that isn't removed can remain and build up in your dog's body and can potentially lead to less-than-optimal health.

The nutrients that assist the detoxification process can become depleted when your dog is under stress, too, exposing their body to even more potential damage from environmental factors.

As threatening as all this sounds, there are **natural** ways to support your dog's normal detoxification processes and promote optimal health.

This starts with diet.

Take your dog's feeding into your own hands.

When you feed your dog a homemade species-specific diet with natural, fresh foods, you know what's in their food.

It might be the most important thing you can do...

Feed your dog a healthy diet.

It's certainly one of the simplest things you can do to help support your dog's normal detox processes.

Helps move lymph fluid to carry toxins to the liver and kidneys where they can be safely eliminated from the body.

Promotes regular bowel movements to move toxins and waste through the digestive tract in a timely manner to help prevent reabsorption.

Regular exercise is essential for not only the normal detoxification process, but also for help in maintaining a healthy weight for your dog, and total body and mind wellness.

Dandelion greens.

Dandelion greens offer many nutritional benefits for dogs.

Dandelion leaves, especially, when grown organically without pesticides, herbicides, and chemical fertilizers, offer a multitude of benefits.

Rich in nutrients, dandelion contains "bitters" which provide the herb's main benefits.

Dandelion gently stimulates and supports liver, kidneys and gallbladder health.

Resveratrol.

Certain plants produce resveratrol as part of their defense system against environmental stressors.

While many people may associate red wine and grapes with resveratrol, that's only one source.

Resveratrol is found in 70 other plants, including pomegranates, raspberries, and Japanese knotweed.

Resveratrol from Japanese knotweed is included in **Liver & Kidney Support** formula because it helps the liver "clean house" by flushing away unwanted fats, promoting optimal function.

Taurine.

Taurine is an important amino acid for liver and gallbladder support. It's essential for optimal blood flow, cardiovascular health, and the production of bile.

Dogs with less-than-optimal levels of taurine may be at greater risk of adverse effects from toxins.

Although a minimal level of taurine is included in most commercial pet foods, taurine is easily depleted in stressed pets.

For the well-being of your dog only decaffeinated green tea leaf extract is used for this formula.

Schisandra fruit supports liver function by stimulating liver enzymes.

Curcumin is what gives turmeric its yellow color.

This potent antioxidant supports your pet's liver and kidney health.

Chlorella supports your dog's normal detoxification processes.

Silica supports the repair process and a healthy bowel.


